Ornamental Crabapple – Green (Spring Snow Crab)	Green leaves & white flowers when in bloom. Tree produces small fruit, crabapples that are berry sized. Varieties we use grow to be between 15'-25' tall and 15'-25' wide.	Fairly drought-tolerant once established not needing a significant amount of water.	
Ornamental Crabapple – Red (Thunderchild Crab)	Red/purple leaves & pink flowers when in bloom. Tree produces small fruit, crabapples that are berry sized. Varieties we use grow to be between 15'-25' high and have 15'-25' spread.	Fairly drought-tolerant once established not needing a significant amount of water.	
Schubert Chokecherry	Green leaves in spring, white flowers when in bloom & purple leaves in the fall. Tree produces small non-edible berries. Grow to 25' tall with a 10'-15' spread.	Berries are not usually messy. Best grown in sunlight and does not tolerate standing water well.	
Brandon Elm	Dark green leaves & no significant ornamental fruit or flowers. Grows to about 40' tall with a 25' spread.	Tree will grow to have a martini glass shape. Best in full sunlight but is adaptable and can tolerate dry conditions and standing water.	
Trembling Aspen	Green leaves, catkin flowers bloom before the leaves grow in the spring, and the fruit produced are small green capsules produced in catkins. Grows to about 35' high and spreads about 25'.	Intolerant to shade, fast growing, but short lifespan. Straight slim trunk with a narrow crown. Fruits, though not significantly ornamental, can be messy.	
Swedish Aspen (Columnar)	Green leaves with branches that go upward creating a narrow column-like shape. Grows on average to 40' with about a 10' spread.	Great for planting in areas with not a lot of room. Does well in cold climates.	
Spruce	A coniferous tree with dark green pine needles. Grows on average to 50' with about a 15' spread.	Tree grows in a pyramid shape with stiff, horizontal branches creating a dense canopy. Sensitive to overwatering.	
Prairie Spire Ash	Grows on average to 40-45' with about a 25' spread. It is an upright narrow tree with rich green foliage.	Vigorous and very hardy tree with a medium to fast growth rate.
